A1	Basic user	Beginner	Can understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type. Can ask and answer questions about personal details. Can interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly.

A2	Basic user	Elementary 2	Can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, employment). Can interact in a simple way with native speakers.
		Pre-Intermediate	Can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters. Can describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate needs.
B1	Independent user	Intermediate 1	Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters. Can describe experiences and events, dreams, hopes and ambitions and briefly give reasons.
		Intermediate 2	Can produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest. Can describe in a more structured way present and past events and can give explanations for opinions and plans.
B2	Independent user	Upper-Intermediate	Can understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics. Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity with native speakers. Can produce clear, detailed text and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.
C1	Proficient User	Advanced	Can understand a wide range of demanding, longer texts and recognise implicit meaning. Can express him/herself fluently and spontaneously without much obvious searching for expressions. Can produce clear, well-structured, detailed text on complex subjects.
C2		Proficiency	Can understand with ease virtually everything heard or read. Can express him/herself spontaneously, very fluently and precisely, differentiating finer nuances of meaning even in more complex situations.

It takes 60-100 lessons to complete each level. At higher levels it might take even more than 100 lessons.
